

# WHO'S PRICE IS RIGHT?

a logic grid game

**To solve:** Read the clues. In the grid, find the place where the column and row match a given situation.

If TRUE, put an O in the box. If FALSE, put an X. When the boxes are filled, the Os are the solutions. **See red example as a guide.** There will be two Os in each column & row.

Everyone in your family has a different favorite fruit and is willing to pay a different price for it. **Can you figure out everyone's favorite fruit & what they're willing to pay?**

## Clues:

- Your sister is willing to spend the least money on her favorite fruit.
- Your brother is willing to spend more than you are.
- **Your sister likes to eat fruit whole instead of cutting it up first.**
- Your dad likes fruit he has to cut up first and will spend \$3.
- Your mom is willing to spend \$4 on her favorite organic strawberries which is more than than your dad willing to spend on his favorite fruit.
- **Hint:** See page 14 under "The Value of Watermelon" for more clues!
